TOMEOWNERS INSURANCE CAN PROTECT YOU from the unexpected. If your home is damaged or your belongings are stolen, it can help cover repairs or replacement, temporary housing and more. For example, if a tree falls through your roof, you'll likely file a property damage claim under your homeowner's policy. But what if you have an incident where you're not sure whether to file a claim? You might not know what is covered under your policy or whether your policy will cover all of the damages. Here are three questions to help you determine what to do next.

Is Mu Loss Covered Under Mu Policu? Understanding what caused the damages to your home or belongings and whether that damage is covered is key to determining whether to file a property insurance claim. Statistics compiled by the Insurance Information Institute show that wind and hail damage is the most common homeowners claim.

Your insurance policy sets forth what is covered and to what extent, so read your policy documents carefully. Once you understand how the damages were caused, you can explore if it might be covered under the policy. Some common causes of damage to your home, belongings and property include wind, hail, theft, fire, vandalism and water (burst pipe). Typically, flood, normal wear and tear, and earthquake are not covered by a standard homeowner's policy. To alleviate any confusion, you can also contact your insurance agent to differentiate coverage.

What's My Deductible? Although you may have a covered loss, the cost of the damages may not exceed your deductible, so you may not

want to file a claim. Minor damages, such as if a few roof shingles blew off in a windstorm, will often cost less to repair or replace than the total amount of your deductible. Generally, if you decide to file a claim that is paid, then your deductible will be subtracted from the amount of your covered loss.

Are There Special Policy Limits That May Apply to My Loss?

Payment for damage to certain types of property may have a special limit that applies to that type of property. For example, jewelry, comic books, collectibles or other valuables, may be limited. These sub-limits could be less than the total amount of damage to that property. This is something to consider when thinking about whether to file a claim.

If You Decide to File a Claim If you have decided to file a claim, you'll want to notify your insurance company as promptly as possible. Getting the process started will allow your insurance company to help you faster. In the meantime, if you make temporary repairs, you should keep a copy of all receipts and provide them to your Claim professional.

If you're reading through your policy and are confused about what's covered, know that you're probably not alone. "Am I covered for this?" is typically the number one question asked by customers. So, if you are also struggling with this question, ask your insurance company or agent to help with the answer. They are usually happy to help. ■



Kevin and his wife, met in 1988 while Kevin was working at Jerry's, a restaurant in Philadelphia. "I was working a few days a week and she was a regular." UNDER PRESSURE

Being a photographer in the middle of a global pandemic seems like a pretty bleak profession, considering the propinquity of your subjects. "When the pandemic struck, and all of my photo jobs suddenly dried up, I was looking for a productive and fulfilling way to spend my days.

"I made an offer on social media, saying I'd come to your house, photograph your family from the front seat of my car, and send you high resolution black-and-white images to use as you please. If you wanted to donate any amount to the project, you could, but if you chose not to, or couldn't afford it for any reason, the offer still stood. I enjoyed the challenge and the limited perspective and always came away satisfied with what we were able to capture. As people were hunkering down in their homes, I expected to be photographing a little more anxiety, if not despair, but the fact that people had something fun and different to downs often more likely to elicit the joy, even goofiness, that appears in many of the images. While most people I know were locked in their homes, I was lucky to be out seeing friends and meeting new people daily, albeit from 30-100 feet away. The community was generous, interest in the project was terrific, and I photographed over 300





delivered in time for an exhibit at Perkins Art Center in Collingswood, NJ this coming November.

LET'S DANCE

Another passion in Kevin's life is obviously music. A major audiophile, music is a big part of Kevin's day to day life, and he wanted to find a way to bring more of that into town.

"When I moved to Collingswood, I loved how close we were to Philly so I could continue to engage with my music community over there, but I soon discovered a wealth of incredibly creative musicians and artists here," explains Kevin. That lightbulb, "a-ha moment', was the birth of Porchfest which debuted in 2017.

"My friend Jake and I went to West Philly Porchfest a few years ago, and after describing it to my friend Stacey Downham, we decided we could do it way better here in Collingswood. Our friend Sara Breyer came onboard to help organize and it gets bigger and better every year. Our friend John Falco designs t-shirts and maps, we print the maps and schedules and people plan their day, criss-crossing town on bikes and on foot to catch all the great talent, both local and from out of town and then the Party family hosts an afterparty. It's a highlight of the year for a lot of people."

Another mashup of music and altruism assembled by Monko was The Beatles/Stones Invitational. Kevin explains, "A few years ago I convinced Ted Velykis at Collingswood Music and Sara O'Brien from Community Rocks to partner up with me and stage The Beatles/Stones Invitational, where we get 30 or so acts to perform one Beatles song and one Rolling Stones song, the public donates money, merchants donate goods and services for auction, and all the proceeds go to music lessons for kids. Because Ted also forgoes his cut of music lesson fees, we can really stretch the money and have managed to give years of lessons to a bunch of deserving kids. We even ask the performers to chip in and they do, which is fantastic."

WILD IS THE WIND

When Kevin isn't busy performing with his bands, or helping to rock Collingswood in the best possible ways, you can find this maverick volunteering in the Collingswood Community Garden on Washington Avenue or the Cattell Avenue location. The mission of the garden is to develop borough open space into community gardens, creating a place for neighbors to work collaboratively and experience the rewards of





gardening. Kevin tends to his own crop plot quite often and spends time tending to the public community garden where they donate the harvested food to local food banks.

Another outlet of interest for Kevin and his wife is traveling to Cliff Island, Maine. "We have traveled to Cliff Island for two weeks every summer since I met my wife in 1988. We fish, hike and bike, take boat rides, do some sports, walk goats, play music, make art, slow down and spend time with friends from all over the country (and Europe) we've made over the years. We even occasionally take a dip in the chilly bay."

A local night out for the couple consists of dinner at their favorite local Italian restaurant, Zeppoli. "We absolutely love eating at Zeppoli." Kevin declares. "A fun fact, owner and chef Joseph Baldino used to be our paperboy in South Philadelphia years ago. It was awesome to see him open this great spot and have all the success of an excellent restaurant that people really enjoy.'

With ending our interview, I asked Kevin what he loved most about living in Collingswood, to which he replied quickly "What I've learned living in this community is how eager people are to chip in and help out when presented with an opportunity. They want to participate in something they can get behind. Volunteerism lives here."



GT IGHTS UP ON WASHINGTON HEIGHTS!" Ready and raring to fire up summer with the final show of its "Grand Reopening" season, The Ritz Theater Company is proud to present *In the Heights*, the Tony Awardwinning musical (and enduring cultural phenomenon) by Lin-Manuel Miranda and Quiara Alegría Hudes. "When I first saw *In the Heights* on Broadway, I was overcome with emotion after the opening number," recalls Mr. Santiago. As if I'm directing what a day in the life was like for me growing up in Camden. Our neighborhood was a very close one. When one person succeeded, the entire neighborhood succeeded. It was commonplace to see my dad on the porch playing his guitar and have our neighbors step out with their own instruments and play along. All the while, we're dancing salsa on the sidewalk. I grew up listening to rap/hip-hop and Spanish music. It almost feels like this 'musical' was written specially for me in some weird sense. I'm sure many other Latinx people who have heard the music or who have seen the musical feel the same way as I do. I had the honor of playing Usnavi in a production of *In the Heights* six years ago. Now I get to direct a new generation of phenomenally talented Latinx actors at the historic Ritz Theatre. I couldn't have asked for a more perfect way to spend my summer."

In the Heights tells the universal story of a vibrant community in New York's Washington Heights neighborhood—a place where the coffee from the corner bodega is light and sweet, the windows are always open, and the breeze carries the rhythm of three generations of music. It's a community on the brink of change, full of hopes, dreams and pressures, where the biggest



struggles can be deciding which traditions you take with you, and which ones you leave behind.

"Although this show is about the lives of a Latinx community over three days, I feel as though everyone, no matter where you're from, can relate to this show," says Mr. Santiago. "A lost loved one. Financial hardships. A strong focus on family and community. These are things that happen everywhere and will always be relevant to all communities. I can't emphasize this enough, but this cast is chock-full of amazingly talented Latinx and Black artists. If I want to see a show about what life is like in this community, then I want to see people who look like me, my family, and my friends. People who go through real-life experiences and struggles just like the next person. It was very important to me to have the community I grew up in represented. I think audiences will see and appreciate it."

Rounding out Mr. Santiago's creative team on this project are music director André Vermeulen, choreographer Katharina Muñiz, and stage manager Mia Rose DiFilippo. In relation to the cast, the production features Julian Pérez as Usnavi, Melany McCarson as Vanessa, Jordan Edmondson as Benny, Naomi Serrano as Nina, AJ Mun as Sonny, Carmen Delia Bryant as Abuela Claudia, Erik Medina as Kevin Rosario, Krista Reinhardt as Camila Rosario, Jen Rosario as Daniela, Emily Colón as Carla, Sanya Johnson as Graffiti Pete, Kyrus Keenan Westcott as Piragua Guy, and performers Kyra Janaé Bryant, Audrey Floyd, Evan Hairston, Armando Mendez, Tiara Nock, Jeremiah Rosado, and Kyle Smith as members of the show's versatile ensemble. All are incredibly excited to bring this vibrant, dynamic, high-energy musical to the Ritz stage and to share this story with the entire community.

"Having people in the audience being able to look up at the stage and see people who look like them was a very big deal for me," says Mr. Santiago. "Representation matters. I've been involved in theater for over 35 years and this is the most diverse cast I have ever worked with. I wanted to make sure that the artists who were involved in this project had the same passion about representing their community as I did. My production staff and I have really made a concerted effort to incorporate different styles of movement in the show from hip hop to salsa. There's something for everyone in this show. We focus on family. Ultimately, I want the young Latinx people who come to see this show know that there is a place for them at The Ritz. There is a place for all of us in the theater. Who knows, maybe this will inspire someone to create the next diverse and inclusive blockbuster like *In the Heights* or *Hamilton*. That's what it's really about." ■





HE TENTH SEASON OF ODYSSEY OF THE MIND IN Collingswood, part of the Collingswood Recreation Program, recently concluded – its most successful yet! We fielded 8 competitive teams (3rd-12th grade) and a non-competitive Primary Club (2nd grade). The program involved more than 60 Collingswood kids and more than 20 adult volunteers who served as coaches, judges, and workshop instructors. All 8 of our teams competed at the Coastal Plains Regional Tournament in March, held at Woodstown High School and at the New Jersey State Finals in April, held Princeton High School. Four of our teams advanced to the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals, held May 25-28 at Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa. Our teams placed 5th, 10th, 11th, and 24th in the world for their respective problems, competing against teams all over the country and the world, including strong teams from Poland and South Korea. The detailed results are shown at left.

In addition to their amazing 5th place finish at World Finals, our Problem 2, Division 3 team received a Ranatra Fusca Award. This award is given to a team or individual for demonstrating outstanding creativity and it embodies the highest honor in OM. This is the first Ranatra Fusca received by a Collingswood Rec OM team at World Finals. In particular, the judges were blown away by the fully playable pipe organ that the team created mostly out of scraps and trash, and which was powered by an air mattress.

Congratulations Quincy Brown, Jack Chunko. Jacob Egerton, Jacob Hwang, Matthew Hwang, Ezra Tapper, and Daniel Wynne for your outstanding creative achievement. And thank you to their longtime and patient coach, Stephen Hwang, who has been an OM coach with our program for the past 9 seasons.

Finally, one of our graduating class of 2022 OMers, Muriel Celia, was honored by the New Jersey Odyssey of the Mind organization with the Rita Ostroff Ginsburg Memorial Scholarship for her 8 seasons as an OMer and her commitment to the values of OM: teamwork, creativity, and perseverance. Though she did not compete in OM herself this season, Muriel served as an assistant coach for one of our Division 1 teams. Congratulations Muriel and good luck in college and beyond!

Collingswood Rec OM is one of the largest and most successful OM programs in New Jersey due to the support we receive from the Collingswood community, especially the Recreation Program headed by Jacob Goodman. Given all the disruptions and



uncertainty of the past two years, it was great to be back in person this year and we are incredibly proud and grateful to have had such a successful season. Congratulations to all our teams and thank you to our hardworking coaches, judges, board members, booster club, and other volunteers.

What is Odyssey of the Mind?

Odyssey of the Mind, known as OM, is an international creativity competition for kids. Teams develop creative solutions to problems and bring their solutions to regional, state, and world competitions. Participating in OM helps kids learn problemsolving, teamwork, inventing and testing, improvisation and performing, visual art and design, engineering, mechanics, and building, writing and storytelling, and presentation skills. OM is also a lot of fun. Kids are encouraged to pursue their ideas with minimal assistance from adults, which can lead to innovative, unexpected, and amazing results! In the past 10 seasons, our Collingswood Rec OM teams have won numerous regional and state awards for their solutions. 20 of our teams have competed at the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals.

Any child in grades 3 through 12 who lives in or goes to school in Collingswood, Oaklyn, or Woodlynne is eligible to participate in Collingswood Rec OM. The season begins in the fall and the tournaments occur March through May.

We are always looking for adults to serve as volunteer coaches, instructors, judges, and other roles. The number of teams is limited by the number of available coaches, so please consider joining us! Mentoring and free coach training is available.






So what's a lift and tint?

A lift does just what it sounds like it does; it lifts, curls, and gives your natural lashes definition. The tint then makes them darker and more noticeable.

Added bonus, less makeup application, equals more time to enjoy the beach and outdoors.

Sounds great, right? Keep reading, it gets better.

The procedure lasts about 45-60 minutes.

First, your lashes are thoroughly cleansed. There can't be anything on them!



EY, I'M KRISTEN, THE FACE, PHOTOGRAPHER, AND writer behind "Eat Local" and a few other things here at Collingswood Living magazine. I adore food. Eating it, cooking it, photographing it, promoting it, and most importantly, sharing it with others!

For the July edition of *Collingswood Living*, I really wanted to share with you one of my favorite subjects - the "sandwich!" I mean what's not to love really? I truly believe people don't realize how much they love a good sandwich. They're insanely versatile and perfect for so many different occasions. Alongside that, I LOVE being creative with food, and with sandwiches the possibilities are just absolutely endless.

My first favorite local sandwich comes from the "OG of Collingswood" sandwich spots, The Pop Shop Collingswood! There's never a shortage of sandwiches to chose from at The Pop Shop, but my favorite "go to" is without a doubt "The Honeymoon" chicken sandwich. This crazy concoction consists of grilled chicken, honey mustard, avocado, caramelized onions, and cheddar on ciabatta. Its a mixture of classic, crazy, simple and fun ingredients, all rolled into one sandwich. The only problem with visiting the Pop Shop is they run monthly specials, which offer limited edition sandwiches for the month, causing the problem of slight betrayal to my classic favorite. The "other" sandwich I'm digging on this month's special board was their "Blueberry Balsamic Grilled Cheese" - a classic grilled cheese paying homage to the "Jersey Blub" and all it's blueberry goodness and glory. This sandwich was an "ooey- gooey" mess of blueberry jam, spinach, and mozzarella cheese, on my favorite type of sandwich bread – sourdough! Both sandwiches were served with fries and a zesty pickle!

To enjoy another local sandwich, I didn't need to go to far, just right down the road a few doors to Maria's Bread Shop. A new kid on the block to Collingswood, Maria's Bread Shop has been slinging sandwiches for years at their Philly location. My favorite is the shaved pork loin sandwich made with fresh Smith Poultry Pork loin, provolone, and broccoli rabe pesto on toasted sourdough. It's nice real nice, and you should probably treat yourself.

The final sandwich on this edition of "Eat Local" comes from Que Rica's and I don't even know where to begin to explain the deliciousness of this sandwich. Que Rica's is also located on Haddon Avenue, but in Westmont. Que Rica's proudly brings authentic and locally inspired South American flavors and Venezuelan street food to South Jersey. There is a ton of great options on the menu to please the palate of any proper foodie, but to stick to the theme, I ordered one of their arepas. An arepa is certainly not a standard looking sandwich, but it still counts in my book and they're a staple of Venezuelan cuisine. Light, fluffy and handmade with corn, they're made daily at Que Rica's and are

stuffed with fillings of your choice. I ordered the "Shaggy," an arepa stuffed with shredded chicken, sweet plantain, fried queso blanco, pico de gallo, and cilantro mojo. It was nothing short of "ahhh-mazzing" and I can't wait to go back and order something else in the name of research!





INGREDIENTS

SALAD

- 3 chicken breasts
- 1½ cups broken vermicelli noodles
- 2 cups fresh bean sprouts
- 4 green onions, sliced
- 3 cups lettuce, shredded
- ¼ cups crushed salted peanuts
- ¼ cup cilantro

DRESSING

- 1/3 cup Thai peanut sauce (see below)
- 1 Tbsp. canola oil
- ½ tsp. sesame oil
- 1 Tbsp. rice vinegar
- 1 tsp. red pepper flakes
- 2 Tbsp. cilantro, minced

THAI PEANUT SAUCE

- 1 cup smooth peanut butter
- ½ cup soy sauce
- ¼ cup lime juice
- ¼ cup rice vinegar
- 2 Tbsp. brown sugar
- 2 Tbsp. fresh ginger
- 1 Tbsp. cayenne pepper
- ½ cup chicken broth

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Brush the chicken with oil and your favorite spices and grill until cooked through.
- 2. Soak the vermicelli in hot water for a few minutes until al dente. Strain out the noodles with a pasta server and bring the water to a boil.
- 3. Blanch the bean sprouts for 30 seconds and drain
- 4. Rinse the noodles and bean sprouts in cold water, and place them in a large serving dish. Then, top them with lettuce and half the green onion.
- 5. In a sealable container, shake all dressing ingredients. Then, pour the dressing over the salad and toss lightly. Garnish with peanuts, cilantro and the remaining green onion. ■
