I recently had the privilege of meeting and chatting with the couple at a local gathering during the holiday season. Within a few minutes, I knew that the Collingswood community should also get to know more about this bubbly and perfectly complimentary pair. After a fun and successful six months of dating, in August 2018

Keisha, a self-propelled entrepreneur, grew up as an only child, just a town away in Pennsauken, New Jersey. She graduated from Pennsauken High School in 2006 and went on to attend college at Lincoln University in Pennsylvania. She majored in education and Spanish studies and spent some time teaching abroad in Spain, before returning home and graduating with a degree in Spanish. After college, and early on in her career, Keshia spent time serving in corporate America with positions ranging from education to accounting and finance. He also travels a lot for work, so it's really important to him that he feels that I'm safe when he's not home." Lavelle, who works as an L.S.A. for the Northeast corridor of Amtrak, is away from home quite often, something Keshia explains. "I grew up as an only child, so I don't mind the alone time," she laughs. "I have so much to do with work, and the TV show, it all keeps me super busy." Collingswood found itself to be as equally convenient for Lavelle's work commute as it had been for Keshia in the past years.







Keshia explains Lavelle's next instructions, "Please put that on and are you going to marry me? I have tried to propose to you two other times and you have messed it up twice now." Thankfully, Keshia accepted the proposal and the two started planning their lives together.


With her father having already passed away, Keshia really didn't want to have a large ceremony. Additionally, her grandmother had suffered a stroke in late December and went into rehab and her grandfather passed away on Christmas Eve. "With so many moving parts, it just seemed ridiculous to plan a large ceremony. Lavelle also didn't want to have a long engagement, so we decided to get married in Las Vegas." With a live Zoom camera running, well before the current popularity of doing things remotely, the couple wed in Vegas with friends and family watching on live footage.

After their nuptials, the couple moved from their apartment to their current single-family home in Collingswood. "We're still renting because this market is crazy right now, but we have hopes to buy someday soon. When we were looking to move into this house, we knew that we both felt strongly about staying in Collingswood. We would love to eventually own a home in Collingswood down the road when we start a family."

In addition to getting married, Keshia has been steadily growing her business consulting agency, LCK Consulting Services and running her own TV show "Morning Coffee" on RVNTV. "The show is sort of like 'The View' in comparison, where it's me and sometimes a co-host, and we discuss current events and what's happening in the world, peppering in our opinions. Occasionally we have guests come on that are influential or doing big things here in South Jersey." Keshia's business consulting agency is also thriving, and is not only a fully black-owned business, but is also fully black operated. "Ten years ago, when I was working in corporate America, the boardrooms that I sat in didn't look like the way they do now. Being a black woman, I had challenges. So, when I became an entrepreneur, one of the most important things to me was to make sure that I was amplifying other black voices. Everyone that works for LCK Consulting Services is African American and has a college degree, because I wanted to showcase what a company like ours looks like in this area, a running, thriving and successful black business." Keshia goes on to explain that it did take her time to grow her team to where it is today, because she was very strategic about her employment selection process. "I wanted to make sure we had the right people representing the company. It's all about company culture, and culture in general. It's extremely important to me that my team understands that what we are doing is bigger than us. It's about being able to make sure that we are being the change, and not just the chatter. We want to make sure we're helping to build that generational wealth that folks so often talk about wanting to build."

When these two busy newlyweds take a moment to unwind, you can find them strolling down Haddon Avenue. "We're big foodies and we love grabbing brunch on the weekends at Sabrina's. The quick walk to restaurants, shops and events is great," explains Keshia. She also enjoys shopping for unusual gifts for friends and family at Occasionette. Keshia and Lavelle both look forward to spending more time here and even growing their family in Collingswood down the road. Winter DRIVING By Jason Connell, Connell Insurance

Minters in this region can be tough, the weather can be unpredictable, and conditions can change quickly on our NJ highways and local Collingswood streets. Snowstorms and icy conditions present a particular set of driving hazards. Icy road fatalities account for more deaths and accidents than all other weather hazards combined (3.6 times more). Preparing your vehicle for the winter and knowing how to react in severe conditions is the key to a safer and less stressful winter season.

So as a professional and licensed insurance agent, I recommend the following measures be taken to avoid an accident during the cold winter months:

BE PREPARED BEFORE A STORM HITS:

- Make sure your auto insurance policy covers you for roadside assistance. Also, check to see if towing is included. If not, for a nominal fee you should add that as a precaution.
- Have a **mechanic** check your car's battery, brakes, fluid levels (antifreeze, properly working windshield wipers and oil) as well as the heating and exhaust systems to ensure that your car is in good, safe working condition.
- Try to keep your **gas tank full** during the winter months. Don't allow the gas to go below half a tank.
- An adequate supply of **windshield washing liquid** is critical to wash away the mud, salt, and melted snow that can severely limit visibility.
- **Prepare for an emergency.** Keep blankets, flares, shovel,







windshield scraper and brush, tool kit, jumper cables, fully charged phone and/or charger plus a flashlight with extra batteries.

WHEN DRIVING UNDER ADVERSE WINTER CONDITIONS:

- Take care pulling out of streets blocked by mountains of snow. It's often difficult to see who or what is coming.
- Back your car into the driveway so you have **better vision** when pulling out.
- Be aware of joggers on the street. Often sidewalks are impassable and die-hard joggers venture onto the street for a clearer path. Unfortunately, they may not see icy spots or other hazards hidden below the slush.

IF YOU MUST TRAVEL DURING A SEVERE STORM:

- Make sure to drive **SLOW**.
- Don't travel alone.
- Make certain your vehicle has **all-wheel drive** or at the very least a high riding clearance (like a truck or an SUV)
- If stuck, stay in the car and wait for help. Run the engine and heater sparingly. Also make sure your exhaust pipe is clear of snow and ventilate your car so that carbon monoxide fumes won't poison you.

Final note: Reach out to your local agent to re-visit your policy and discuss the benefits that best meet your needs. Wishing you safe travels this winter. ■

2. PERFORMING UP CLOSE TASKS HAS BECOME IMPOSSIBLE

Cataract formation is a relatively slow process. Typically, most agerelated cataracts develop over a span of years, and they only become a problem when they begin interfering with your everyday life.

This can make it much more challenging to perceive fine details or distinguish colors. For most, the solution is cataract surgery to remove the natural lens and replace it with an artificial lens.

This will enable you to see more clearly and allow you to enjoy every beautiful, vivid color the world has to offer once more.

5. YOU SUDDENLY START HAVING DOUBLE VISION Although it sounds unusual, you may start experiencing something called double vision when you have cataracts. It's essential to see your eye care professional as soon as possible to determine what's causing your double vision.

Most cataract patients report double vision in one eve. If you have double vision, it becomes almost impossible to complete any activity. Until you have cataract surgery, avoid activities like lifting, driving, or cooking.

6. YOUR PRESCRIPTION KEEPS CHANGING As a result of aging. it's normal for any prescriptions for your contact lenses or glasses to change over time. But if you find that these prescriptions keep changing more and more, this could be a sign of having cataracts.

One of the problems with having a cataract is that you will eventually get to a point where glasses and contacts will no longer improve your eyesight. When that happens, you'll need cataract surgery to have your vision corrected.



OO MUCH SCREEN TIME over the past decade and its residual effects on young people have been exacerbated by the pandemic response of "educating by isolating." - 2. Kids naturally make friends. Thousands of new campers arrived at camps the past two summers, and it was amazing to see how they were drawn towards one another; quickly building friendships, with their saved up love and empathy.



- 3. Kids love being outdoors. Always have. But after being forced indoors for so long, kids cared less about the bugs, the dirt and mud, the liquid sunshine, and even the heat! At Liberty Lake, we embrace the opportunity to jump into a lake, just like kids have done for thousands of years!
